6th June 1944 - D-Day: 75 years ago, after almost five years of war and following many months of planning, preparation and training, the Allied forces, in the largest seaborne invasion in history, landed on the beaches of Hitler's "Fortress Europe". The loss of life was not in vain, however. The Normandy invasion was the beginning of the end of the war.
